

TEXAS ALL-SPORTS STANDINGS

Here are all-sports standings for Division I conferences other than the Big 12 that include Texas colleges. These standings are compiled separately from the U.S. Sports Academy Directors' Cup all-sports standings and use different formulas that are determined by the conferences. **Note:** Conference USA (Houston, Rice, SMU and UTEP) and the Mountain West Conference (TCU) do not calculate all-sports standings.

The all-sports trophies in men's and women's competition are awarded on a 12-point system for all conference sports, with values of 12, 11, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2 and 1 point, based on place of finish. Points are awarded regardless of the number of teams competing in the championship.

Point totals from the men's and women's all-sports standings are combined to determine the Commissioner's Cup winner.
