

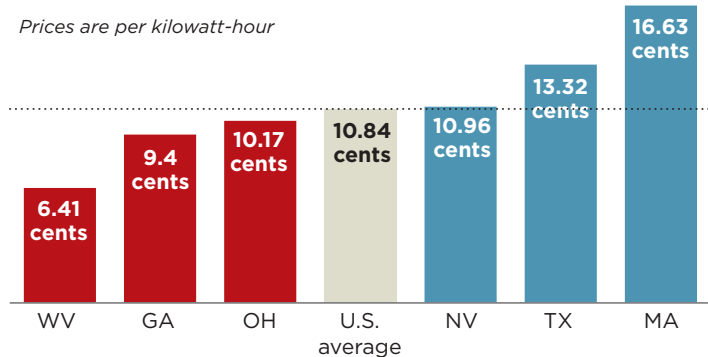
COMPARING STATES

Texas households paid more for electricity in June than most people in the U.S. That's partly because most power in Texas is generated using natural gas, a fuel that is more expensive than coal. States that mostly use coal tend to have lower electricity prices than natural gas states.

■ Coal states generate more than half of their power using coal

■ Natural gas states generate more than half of their power using natural gas

Prices are per kilowatt-hour

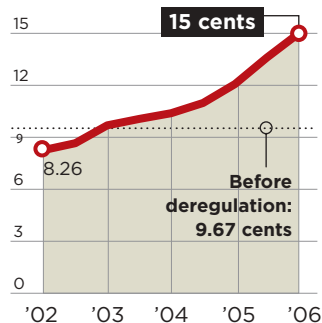

TXU'S PRICE TO BEAT

TXU has raised its price to beat eight times since deregulation began in 2002, as natural gas prices have risen. The TXU price applies only to those customers in North Texas who haven't chosen a different price plan.*
